Re: Results Day 2021

It is with great pleasure that I am writing to invite you to attend our Results Day on Thursday 12 August 2021 to receive your TAG results. The Bay CE School has determined grades in accordance with the JCQ guidance¹ and has submitted these grades to the relevant awarding organisation by the required deadline. To support your understanding, please refer to Ofqual's guidance [Student guide to awarding: summer 2021](#)² which tells you how your grade has been determined in summer 2021 and where you can get more information.

Arrangements for results day

- 9.00 start 11.00 end
- Students line up (socially distanced) in front of the school, outside reception, between 9 and 11am and enter when invited
- Enter through the lecture theatre outside doors, sanitizing hands as you enter
- Collect your envelope from the Lecture Theatre
- Post-16 representatives will be available to speak to
- Students move to East Playground to speak with staff and to share messages
- Wet weather contingency is to use East Hall
- Students leave via the Sports Hall Exit, sanitizing hands as you leave
- Parents can collect student results if they have a letter of authority from the student (with student's full name and exam number), naming the person collecting the results, and a form of picture identification of the parent
- Any student who has not collected their results by 11.00, results will be left at reception for collection
- Should the results still be at school by 13.00, they will be posted home
- Students not attending can receive results by phone after 10.00am. They must provide their full name and exam number.

Certificates

- Will be received from awarding organisations in late November 2021 when a message will be shared on Facebook and the school website informing students that certificates can be collected.
- Students should ring reception on 403284 to book an appointment to collect their certificates.
- Parents can collect student's certificates, by appointment, if they have a letter of authority from the student (with student's full name and date of birth), naming the person collecting the results, and a form of picture identification
